DASH EARN COME-FROM-BEHIND WIN LUIS GONZALEZ 2.0?

Thanks to a five-run seventh inning, Winston-Salem outlasted the Salem Red Sox 6-5 on Thursday night at Haley Toyota Field. With the first half, **Luis Gonzalez** has continued his victory, the Dash split their four-game set against the Red Sox. Trailing 4-1 entering the seventh, the Dash offense sent 11 men to the plate, using a posted ten multi-hit contests, including three Ti'Quan Forbes RBI single, a Red Sox error, consecutive two-hit games. Overall, the former bases-loaded walk, and a hit-by-pitch to take the lead. **John Parke** earned the win, allowing four runs while tying a season-high with seven innings pitched. **Danny Dopico** picked up his fourth save of the year with a scoreless ninth.

SHEETS SHOWING UP

Dash first baseman **Gavin Sheets** has been in a groove in the second half of the season. Through 21 games after the All-Star Break, Sheets is batting .365 (31-for-85) with eight doubles, two homers and 15 RBIs. A former second-round pick by the White Sox out of Wake Forest University, Sheets' 31 hits since June 21 are tied for fifth-most in all of Minor League Baseball. Prior to joining the White Sox organization, Sheets was a three-year star for the Demon Deacons, registering 21 homers and 84 RBIs in his final season in 2017.

After earning a Midseason All-Star nod in the South Atlantic League with Low-A Kannapolis in the first half, **Luis Gonzalez** has continued his strong work at the plate with the Dash. In 18 games played for Winston-Salem, Gonzalez has posted ten multi-hit contests, including three consecutive two-hit games. Overall, the former third-round pick is hitting .333 with 10 doubles, a homer and 12 RBIs with the Dash. The 22-year-old Gonzalez played three years at the University of New Mexico before joining the White Sox organization last year.

MUSCLE EMOJI

Thanks to their strong second-half start, Dash are atop the Carolina League in several offensive categories, including runs (466), doubles (187), triples (27), hits (825), RBIs (440) and slugging percentage (.421). Meanwhile, the Dash rank second in the circuit in home runs (73) and on-base percentage (.343).

DOPICO DOMINANCE

Danny Dopico has reeled off eight scoreless appearances in his last 10 outings, allowing just one earned run in the process. Since May 27, the right-hander has three saves in three tries and a 0.68 ERA in 13.1 innings while striking out 16 and walking just four.

MARTINEZ MARCHES ON

Last time out, Martinez tied a season-high with seven innings, allowing just two runs on five hits against Down East to earn his third consecutive win. The Venezuelan right-hander has found a groove over the last month. Since June 10, Martinez is 3-0 with a 2.79 ERA, racking up 25 strikeouts against nine walks in 29.0 innings.

DASH DOTS

Blake Rutherford currently leads all White Sox farmhands with 58 RBIs...The Dash are 5-5 against Buies Creek this season, last facing the Astros from May 21-24 at BB&T Ballpark.

BEGINNING OF A NEW ERA

Martinez's signing (\$250,000) in 2011 with the White Sox marks a significant point in the White Sox rebuild. The right-hander was the first signing in the **Marco Paddy** era. Paddy, the White Sox Director of International Scouting, began his tenure with the club in 2011, following the aftermath of the signing-bonus skimming scandal that affected the White Sox. Two years after the signing of Martinez, the club signed Cuban slugger **Jose Abreu** to a six-year deal. That same year, the club signed the No. 2 international prospect, current Dash outfielder **Micker Adolfo**. The top-rated prospect in 2013 was outfielder **Eloy Jimenez**, who the South Siders traded for last season. Chicago also traded for former international top prospect **Yoan Moncada**, the starting second baseman for the White Sox.

FLASH OF BRILLIANCE

Martinez struggled in his first year of full season ball with Low-A Kannapolis in 2015. The righty went 4-14 with a 5.38 ERA in 24 starts, allowing nearly a hit per inning (102H to 108.2 IP) and dropping his last five decisions of the season (August 3 to September 4). However, Martinez did show a sign of things to come right before that five-loss skid ensued. The 6-4 hurler spun eight shutout innings at Lakewood on July 27, 2015, giving up just two hits and one walk while striking out four to earn his fourth and final win of the season. At the time, it was just the fourth zero-run performance he had turned in as a starter in the professional ranks. He would improve across the board in 2016 during his second go-around at the Low-A level, going 8-9 with a 3.81 ERA over 137.0 IP with 141 strikeouts.
